Drawing your attention towards the BSNL Tower located at Yercaud. I served as a doctor for Youreka Group which operates camps at Yercaud. The network of BSNL is feeble and many users prefer BSNL for its track record. Much of the communication work gets difficult because of the network issue. At certain locations of the camp there is one or two signal signs being recorded, but there is no consistency.

At this juncture, it would be of real help if BSNL could install an IBS Booster which powers the signal received from the tower. Should Youreka company bear the cost of the booster, that could be explored too. Requesting your help in this regard. The people who work at the camp base struggle to connect with their families and for work related engagements. In their bearings I saw my own struggle too while I served there.

It is hopeful that your office will act soon, if this request is turned down, it will be a stigma on all the good things that BSNL does in the locality.
